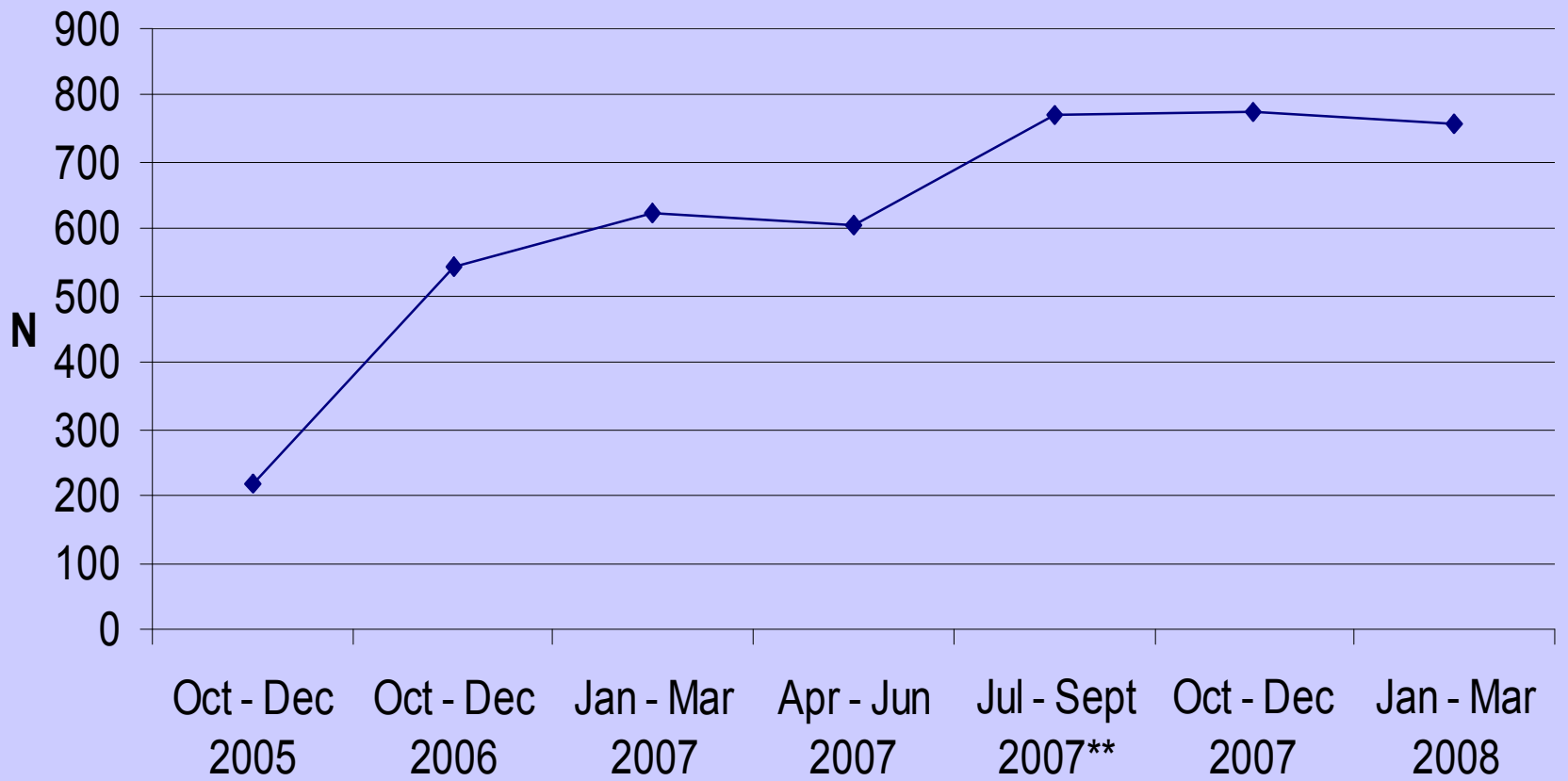


## Admissions to outpatient or intensive outpatient services by STAR-SI participating agencies



# Results

- There were 219 admissions during the baseline quarter of Oct.-Dec. 2005 (n=9 pilots).
- 323 additional admissions during the first year of the OSA PI Pilot from Oct. 2005-December of 2006 (n=9), a 247% increase over baseline;
- Admissions increased to 625 in the first quarter of 2007, a 285% increase over baseline;
- July 2007 5 new STAR SI Year 2 pilot agencies data were added to the data set (n=14);
- As of March 2008 there is a 345% increase in admissions (537) over baseline since Maine began using NIATx PI to increase Treatment Access and Retention.

# Maine Star SI Baseline Data & Timeline:

- Baseline Data October-December 2005 (n=9)
- OSA NIATx PI Pilot Project Begins January 2006 with 9 pilots (became STAR Yr 1 pilots)
- May 2006 State Association of Addiction Services (SAAS) funded MASAP, one of only three state associations in the nation, to demonstrate effective partnership outcomes through collaboration between MASAP, the Maine Office of Substance Abuse, and Brown University's New England ATTC.
- STAR SI Grant Received October 2006
- Second Year Pilots join LC Sept. 2007 – added 5 pilot agencies to the Learning Collaborative
- Data slide reflects addition of 2<sup>nd</sup> year pilots in Oct-Dec. 2007 (n14)
